Motion by Councilman Davis to approve and adopt Resolution R-40-16, a Resolution of the City of Glenn Heights City Council Certifying the Election


Results for the November 8, 2016 General Election; Declaring the Results; Providing a Severability Clause; and Providing for an Effective Date.
