The different signs are warning signs, regulatory signs, and guiding signs. Warning signs are yellow and orange. For example, pedestrian signs and construction signs. These signs can show changes to the road conditions. The next sign is called a regulatory sign. Regulatory signs are red, black, and white. These signs are the law.
