**What Municipal Courts Do:** Jail Magistrations, Arraignments, Examining Trials, Pre-Trial Hearings, Bench And/Or Jury Trials, Show Cause Hearings, Indigency Hearings, Mental Health Hearings, Dangerous Dog Hearings, Code Enforcement Hearings (i.e., junk vehicles, animals, weeds and debris, signs, etc.), Sub-Standard Structures Hearings, School Attendance Hearings, Driver's License Suspension Hearings, Stolen Property Hearings, Bond Revocation Hearings, Juvenile Magistrate Warnings, Civil Abatement Hearings and Injunctive Relief; Review/Issue Search, Inspection, Seizure and Arrest Warrants; Issue Emergency Protective Orders, Ignition Interlock Orders, Community Service Orders, Expunction Orders, Record Retention and Destruction Orders
