Are you thinking of making upgrades or changes to your home or property?

Permits are required for:

- **Additions, decks, enclosures**
- **Fences, garages, sheds**
- **Electrical, hot water heaters, plumbing, water lines**
- **Roofs, siding, windows**
- **Driveways, approaches, sidewalks, steps**

Weeds & Grass

Property owners and tenants are responsible for keeping their lawns mowed.



Parking of Vehicles

Vehicles must be parked on an improved surface. May not park on sidewalks, in yards or blocking driveways.

Trash Placement

Receptacles may not be placed out prior to 7 p.m. the day of collection and must not be blocked.



Nuisance Vehicles

Inoperable vehicles, wrecked, dismantled, flat tires, invalid/expired registration or vehicles used for storage are considered a nuisance.

Illegal Dumping

Unauthorized use of dumpster, trash and debris on public or private property.



Unclean Premises

Properties should be kept free of unsightly matter, trash, debris, and junk.

Dilapidated Fence

Missing pickets, structural members, damage, rotted or missing panels is considered dilapidated and must be repaired.



Commercial Vehicles

Commercial vehicles are not permitted to be parked in residential areas.

Address Posting

Emergency services relies on clear and visible numbers when responding to requests for aid. Min. 4" in heights and contrasting in color to surface posted on.



Illegal Signs

Signs may not be posted on utility poles or in medians.
