

FIRE

On Tuesday, May 3, 2022, The Glenn Heights Fire Department responded to McCowan Middle School for a structure fire with smoke in the building. Neighboring departments Red Oak Fire, Ovilla Fire, Desoto Fire, Cedar Hill Fire all arrived to assist with the call. This call is still under investigation.



From April 22, 2022, to May 5, 2022, the Glenn Heights Fire Department responded to 68 calls for service. There were 45 EMS calls for service and 23 Fire calls for service. The response times were 1:06 for EMS calls and 1:17 for Fire calls.

PARK AND RECREATION

The Senior Center re-opened to Glenn Heights seniors on Monday, May 2, 2022. City staff were happy to welcome back seniors for fellowship and good times! POLICE



On April 25, 2022, officers were dispatched to the intersection of Uhl Rd. @ Creekside Dr. regarding a male running toward Parkerville Rd. after discharging a handgun. The male was located in the 1400 blk of Caleo Dr. and found to be in possession of a handgun. The subject was arrested for Deadly Conduct and Unlawful Carrying of a Weapon.

On 5/9/22, the Citizens Police Advisory Committee (CPAC) met at the Senior Center. Lt. Shields provided them with a presentation outlining the Police Department's control device policy. This presentation included information about the use of the Taser, restraint devices, chemical munitions, OC Spray, and Pepper ball projectiles.

To better understand the workings and proper procedures of the Police Department, CPAC members are scheduled to participate in training scenarios on May 14 & 28, 2022.
