

## Senior Walking Club


Open to Seniors 55 and over.

On April 4, 2023, Mayor Sonja A. Brown read a Proclamation recognizing April 9-15, 2023, as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week. Mayor Brown presented Glenn Heights Dispatch Supervisor Terri Niemietz with the Proclamation.

## FIRE DEPARTMENT



Between Thursday, March 24, 2023, and Thursday, April 6, 2023, the GHFD responded to 81 calls for service - 50 EMS and 31 Fire. The average turnout time was 1.22 minutes for EMS, and 1.25 minutes for Fire.



On Tuesday, April 4, 2023, the Glenn Heights Fire Department responded to a punctured 3" gas line at Ovilla Rd. and Santa Rosa Dr. Multiple houses were evacuated.

## FIRE DEPARTMENT (CONTINUED)



On Tuesday, March 28, 2023, E301 and C301 were called for mutual aid on a structure fire in Red Oak. E301 arrived on scene to find a one-story house with heavy fire. E301 entered the structure for primary search and found/rescued a caged rabbit.


## PUBLIC WORKS

March 23, 2023 - April 5, 2023: Trash pickup during park rounds and Right of Way mowing - crews picked up 94 bags of trash.




March 28, 2023: Water service line leak on Saline Creek Dr., crews replaced a 1" copper water service line.

April 3, 2023: Water service line repair on Red Oak Creek Dr., crews replaced a 3/4" poly water service line that was split near the main line.

April 5, 2023: Pothole repairs on S. Uhl Rd., crews cut out and replaced damaged asphalt.



March 23, 2023 - April 5, 2023: Asphalt Road repairs on Uhl Rd. and Bear Creek Rd. Contractors milled and patched several sections of Bear Creek Rd., as well as repaved Uhl Rd. from Bear Creek to Creekside.
