



Boards and Commissions

Volunteers are vital to the operations of the City. The City of Glenn Heights simply could not operate without the countless hours that citizens contribute while serving on a city board, committee, or commission.

Planning and Zoning Commission – Advises the City Council on issues related to commercial and residential development, zoning, development plans, and master plan amendments.

Zoning Board of Adjustments - A statutorily created-board which is authorized to make special exceptions or grant variances to the Zoning Ordinance, to hear and decide any appeals that allege error in an order, requirement, decision or determination made by an administrative official in the enforcement of the Zoning Ordinance, and any other powers or duties granted by the City Council.

Parks & Recreation Board – Advises the City Council on issues related to the City park system, including recreational programs and facilities.

Building and Standards Commission - A Quasi-Judicial Commission which is authorized to make determinations on the enforcement of Health and Safety Ordinances regarding the vacation, relocation of occupants, securing, repair, removal, or demolition of a building or structure that is dilapidated, substandard, or unfit for human habitation and a hazard to the public health, safety, and welfare, as recognized in section 214.001 (a) (1) of the Texas Local Government Code.

All members must be residents and qualified voters of the City of Glenn Heights. All members of city boards, committees, or commissions are appointed by the City Council.
