If the Defendant fails to comply, a **capias pro fine warrant** may be issued for the Defendant's arrest for the remaining amount of the fine and costs and a \$50 warrant fee. If it becomes delinquent by 60 days or more, this case will be turned over to a collection agency and an additional 30% fee will be assessed.

JUDGMENT

ON THIS the ____ day of _____, 20____, the Defendant having entered his/her plea of No Contest/Guilty, waiving his/her right to jury trial and being found guilty by the court and assessed a fine of \$_____, has agreed to pay the fine and costs on or before the 30th day from the date of judgment. However, if any portion of the fine and costs is paid on or after the 31st day after the date of judgment, the Defendant shall pay an additional \$25 as required by Sec. 133.103 L.G. If judgment is not paid in full by the 30th day, the defendant will be expected to pay a minimum of \$100 down on by that date. Defendant is **ORDERED** to notify the Court of any changes of address.

Ordered and Adjudged by the State of Texas, for the use and benefit of the City of Glenn Heights, Texas, does have and recover from the Defendant the amount, plus any and all costs required to be paid.

It is further Ordered and Adjudged, if the Defendant fails to comply with the orders of this judgment, the Defendant shall be committed to the custody of the Chief of Police of the City of Glenn Heights, Texas until said fine and costs are fully paid. In the event the Defendant defaults in the discharge of this judgment, pursuant to Article 45.048(b), Code of Criminal Procedure, the Court specifies that the Defendant remain in jail a sufficient length of time to satisfy the fine and costs.
