

**DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER AND STATE OF  
EMERGENCY  
EFFECTIVE AUGUST 22, 2022**

**WHEREAS**, on August 22, 2022, the City suffered widespread damage and injury to property as a result of the torrential rainfall and the resulting flooding; and

**WHEREAS**, reasonable measures must be taken to cope with this disaster to prevent effects throughout the City of Glenn Heights and Dallas and Ellis Counties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governor has declared a state of emergency for 23 counties, including Dallas and Ellis Counties by proclamation for such conditions

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, HARRY A. GARRETT, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF GLENN HEIGHTS, TEXAS, DO HEREBY DECLARE** on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August 2022, a local state of disaster and emergency; and:

1. That a local state of disaster for public health and safety emergency is hereby declared for the City of Glenn Heights, Texas, pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to section 418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster for public health and safety emergency shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from August 22, 2022, unless the same is continued or renewed by consent of the City Council of the City of Glenn Heights, Texas.
3. Pursuant to section 418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster for public health and safety emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
4. Pursuant to section 418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City of Glenn Heights emergency management plan.
5. The order is subject to the Proclamation of the Governor pursuant to Section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code, any regulatory statute prescribing the procedures for conduct of state business or any order or rule of a state agency that would in any way prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action in coping with this disaster shall be suspended upon written approval of the Office of the Governor. However, to the extent that the enforcement of any state statute or administrative rule regarding contracting or procurement would impede any state agency's emergency response that is necessary to protect life or property threatened by this declared disaster. I hereby authorize the suspension of such statutes and rules for the duration of this declared disaster.
6. I further direct the City Manager, or his designee, to undertake whatever reasonable action and to conduct whatever disaster mitigation measures necessary to protect the

general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Glenn Heights under the Emergency Management Plan as necessary.

7. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
