**U.S. Small Business Administration Offers Disaster Relief to Dallas County**

*Low-Interest Loans Available for Residents, Nonprofits, & Businesses Impacted by March 4<sup>th</sup> Severe Weather*

**DALLAS, Texas** ---The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) is offering low-interest federal disaster loans to help Dallas County businesses, nonprofits, and residents recover from the severe weather event on March 4, 2025. Those who suffered physical or economic damages may be eligible for financial assistance.

Businesses and nonprofits can apply for business physical disaster loans, with loan amounts of up to \$2 million available to repair or replace disaster-damaged real estate, machinery, equipment, inventory, and other business assets.

Homeowners and renters may qualify for home and personal property loans, with funding available up to:

- \$100,000 for personal property, including clothing, furniture, vehicles, and appliances.
- \$500,000 for homeowners to repair or replace their primary residence.

Additionally, applicants may be eligible for a loan increase of up to 20% of their physical damages (as verified by the SBA) for mitigation improvements. These improvements may include insulating pipes, weatherproofing windows and doors, or installing storm-resistant features to reduce future disaster risks.

"The severe weather on March 4 left many of our residents, businesses, and nonprofits with unexpected physical and economic damage. I encourage all eligible residents to take advantage of these low-interest loans to restore their homes, businesses, and livelihoods so that our community can rebuild and recover," said Dallas County Judge Clay Lewis Jenkins.

On Monday, March 24, a Disaster Loan Outreach Center will open in Irving, Texas. SBA customer service representatives will be available to assist residents and businesses, answer questions, and provide additional information about available relief. While walk-ins are welcome, appointments may also be scheduled at [appointment.sba.gov](https://appointment.sba.gov).
